Administrative History:

The Dublin Sanitary Association was founded in 1872 to improve the '*very defective sanitary arrangements in Dublin*'. The four main objectives of the Association were;

- to educate the public about sanitary matters,
- direct attention to areas where existing powers were not fully exercised
- monitor the course of sanitary legislation,
- and to form a body in which the public would have confidence and which could act on behalf of the public.

The Sanitary Association was run by a committee, with a treasurer, honorary secretaries and a President. The Association lasted into the 1910s, and throughout its existents was actively involved in raising awareness of, and improving, sanitary conditions in Dublin.
