Description:

Small collection of records of the Adelaide Hospital, Dublin, including financial records of the Medical Board and casebooks created by physicians and surgeons in the hospital.

Arrangement:

Records have been divided by type, with the casebooks divided by creator. Items within these groups have been arranged chronologically.

Administrative History:

The Adelaide Hospital opened in 1839 in a house on Bride Street in Dublin, as a hospital for Protestant patients. The hospital on Bride Street closed in 1848, reopening ten years later on Peter Street. The new hospital was much larger than the original, and from the first allowed for clinical teaching. This teaching was overseen by the Hospital's Medical Board, made up of the hospital's three physicians and three surgeons. The hospital was granted a Royal Charter in 1920, one of the last to be granted in Ireland. The Adelaide Hospital closed in 1998, when it was incorporated as part of the new Tallaght Hospital.

Custodial History:

Material was rescued from a skip outside the Adelaide Hospital following its closure in 1998, it was donated to the RCPI Heritage Centre in 2013.

Description:

Financial records of the Medical Board of the Adelaide Hospital, including records of students' fees, account, receipt and bank books.

From 1858 the Adelaide Hospital admitted medical students for clinical instruction in the hospital. The fees paid by these patients went to the Medical Board, made up of the hospital's three physicians and three surgeons.

Description:

Bound volume containing details of students entered in the Adelaide Hospital medical school between 1858 and 1866. Entries give the following information on each student; names, residence, date of entry, paid on entry, paid balance, period entered for and observations. The observations column is mainly used to record where the student was studying medicine, or who they are studying under. Notes relating to the issuing of certificates have been added to some entries.

Additional sheets giving details of the Medical Board's accounts have been added, these include details of income from students, expenditure and the division of the dividends between the board's members.

Description:

The casebook is comprised on preprinted pages with space to record; name, address, date, disease, occupation, result, followed by detailed case notes. The volume contains records for over 200 cases. The first 20 cases date from 1896 and were presumably treated by Franks. The remainder of the cases, written in a different hand, are from the years 1904 to 1908. In most cases the fields relating to the patient have been completed, and they are accompanied by notes covering the condition, treatments, operations carried out and results. On a small number of occasions the notes are accompanied by a ink sketch of interesting features.

The casebook has an index at the front, cases are indexed both by patient name and disease across the two time periods.

Description:

Record of cases seen in the Adelaide Hospital between July 1898 and July 1900. For each case the patient's name, age, address and disease is given followed by a case history, summary of present condition and a dated record of treatment. The casebook has an index at the front, cases are indexed both by patient name and disease. Towards the back of the volume there is a list of operations carried out during the two year period, detailing patient's name and age, the date and type of operation. The operations listed match to the cases recorded in the book.

Given the time period covered and the references to other doctors in the notes it is possible the casebook was kept by a student or resident in the hospital.

Description:
An incomplete series of casebooks of diseases of the skin, compiled by Wallace Beatty during his time at the Adelaide Hospital. Beatty was appointed physician to the Adelaide Hospital in 1894 and remained in post until his death in 1923. Beatty took charge of the dispensary for diseases of the skin at the hospital, and devoted much of his career to the practice of dermatology.

The casebooks are made up of preprinted sheets with spaces for the patient's name, age, occupation and address, the date of consultation and the disease, followed by case notes and remarks. In most cases the notes are divided under headings including; Appearance, Location, Inspection, Duration, Treatment and Remarks. The notes are made in a series of different hands presumably by students/assistants to Beatty, in some cases the name of the doctor taking the notes is given.
