| Professional Qualifications/Education | Undergraduate performance (relevant qualifications/primary degrees e.g. BSc, or that may have been obtained as an intercalated primary degree during undergrad training), teaching awards, higher degrees (MD, MCh, MSc, MPhil, PhD MRCP, MRCP) | 5 |
| Publication & Audit Experience | Publications, specialty publications, presentations, posters, audit | 5 |
| Clinical Practice | Candidate shows evidence that present achievement and performance is commensurate with the totality of the period of training, e.g. experience in specialty, attendance at specialty clinics etc. | 5 |
| Leadership & Management Experience | Candidate demonstrates that they have held a leadership or management role e.g. Lead NCHD, hospital committee membership, clinical risk management, Quality management | 2.5 |
| Teaching Experience | Candidate demonstrates experience with teaching or higher qualification in teaching | 2.5 |
