After meeting eligibility criteria:

Category	Description	50 Marks*
Professional Qualifications/Education/Achievements	Undergraduate performance, teaching awards, higher degrees. Professional and Extracurricular achievements.	10
Clinical experience in specialty	Adequate exposure and experience in specialty. Commitment to specialty such as attendance at national/international meetings and specialty courses, membership of learned societies and specialty journal subscription	10
Career progression and General suitability	Candidate shows evidence that present achievement and performance is commensurate with the totality of the period of training, eg time taken to achieve MRCP, proportional clinical experience in specialty and attendance at specialty meetings, specialty predominant publications/presentations and course attendance.	10
Publication & Audit Experience	Publications, specialty publications, presentations, posters, audit, quality improvement programmes	10
Leadership & Management Experience	Candidate demonstrates that they have held a leadership or management role eg. Lead NCHD, hospital committee membership, organising membership examinations, audit or quality improvement programmes	5
Teaching Experience	Candidate demonstrates experience with teaching or higher qualification in teaching	5
