KEY FINDINGS



The Training Post Evaluation (TPE), launched by RCPI in 2016, gives Trainees the opportunity to provide honest and anonymous feedback on their training experiences.

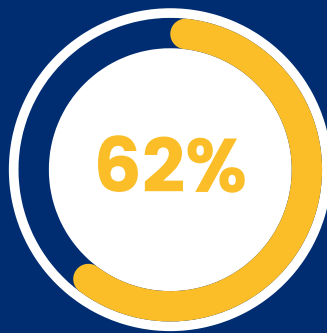
Findings from the first five years of the Training Post Evaluation (2016 - 2020) have been published in a new report.

The findings are based on feedback received from doctors in Basic and Higher Specialist Training programmes in 86 training sites across Ireland.

likely to recommend their training post to their colleagues

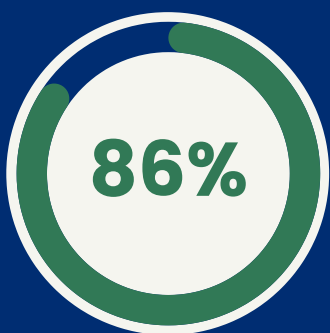


felt that their working environment fully supports the confidence building of doctors in training

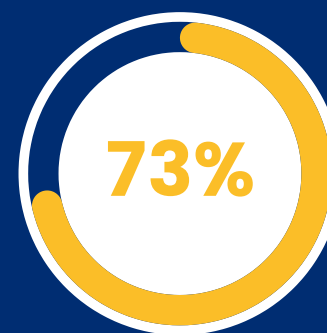


felt they were offered exposure to broad clinical case mix

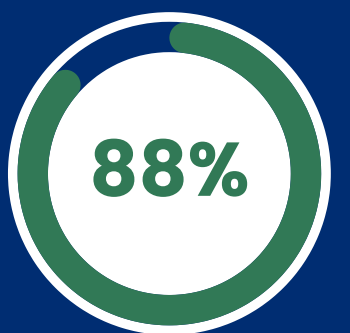
Doctors in Higher Specialist Training

Key findings identified for improvement

- **Response rates**
A prize draw will be introduced for the 2021 TPE to increase response rate and it will become mandatory for the new intake of Trainees
- **1 in 5 BST and 1 in 10 HST felt that their Trainer and/or workplace were not supportive**
RCPI is developing a Trainer Programme to support and engage with our Trainer community
- **In many posts (40% BST, 31% HST), Trainees did not always know who was providing their clinical supervision**
- **They also felt they were not receiving regular and timely feedback on their performance**
RCPI plan to follow this up through the new model of Site QI Visits
